

## How to submit your homework to EEE for ICS 45C

**Important:** make sure your programs can be compiled and executed on the computers of `openlab.ics.uci.edu`

This is the **ONLY** environment that your programs would be executed for grading.

As for the format of files to be submitted for each homework


<Example for Lab 1>

If not explicitly specified, by default the file name should be like `lab1_1.cpp`

<hwNumber \_ problem number with correct file extension>

Write one file per program(problem).

**Important:** besides these files, provide a write-up as proof of successful execution on openlab for each problem. The write-up should include screenshots/photos of steps of execution on openlab for each problem. The reader would **ONLY** verify and grade those problems which have corresponding proof of successful execution on openlab in the write-up. However, the write-up does not need to be a formal report.

Taking problem1 in lab1 as an example, you should submit a program named `lab1_1.cpp`

When you log onto openlab, ① the terminal automatically shows your UCInetid as identification

② compiling the program


③ execution of the program and the outputs
