

Staying on the UC Irvine campus for the WNAR/IMS meeting

UC Irvine offers room and board package rates on a per person, per night cost. This includes housing in a residence hall and 3 meal a day cycle.

Dates: Arrival – Saturday, 6/23/07; Departure – Wednesday, 6/27/07

First & Last meal TBD

No Refunds for late arrivals, early departures, missed meals.

Room and Board Package Options

On-campus housing for conference will be in the Middle Earth Housing Complex. Halls in Middle Earth are dormitory style (5-6 rooms sharing bathroom facilities).

Both double-occupancy and single-occupancy room and board options include Linens consisting of: one blanket, two sheets, one pillowcase, one pillow, a towel, hand towel and a washcloth.

Double Occupancy option – \$55.50 night per person

2 people assigned to 1 sleeping room

Each sleeping area is furnished with two twin beds.

Single Occupancy option (subject to availability) – \$68.50 /night per person

Reservations: To reserve an on-campus Room and Board Plan, fill out the housing portion of the meeting registration form. Reservations to stay on campus for the WNAR/IMS meeting must be received by June 10, 2006. Space is somewhat limited, and is available on a first-come first-served basis.

Front Desk/Check-In/Check-Out:

Middle Earth has a desk staffed with Student Conference Assistants (CAs) who are there to help with general information and directions. Desk hours are: Monday-Friday, 8a-9p and Saturday-Sunday 10a-9p. After hours, when the desk is closed, a Conference Assistant is on-call for emergencies.

Participants will receive their room key and meal card at check-in. There is a \$25 fee for lost keys, which is billed to conference.

Dining:

Upon check-in, each conference participant staying in the residence hall will receive a meal card for use in the Dining Commons for meals taken in the Commons. Catered meals or special events may have other arrangements. Pippin Commons is located with in the Middle Earth Complex.

Can I still eat if I lose my meal card?

Meal cards can be replaced for a fee (\$10) at the Middle Earth Conference Office.

Telephones: Each hall has a telephone located outside the hall. These phones dial on-campus extensions or to 911. Pay telephones are located across from Brandywine Recreation Room and upstairs from the Conference Office. Important messages may be left for conference participants at the Conference Office and will be posted on the bulletin board in the office.

Spouses and Significant Others:

Only registered conference participants are permitted to stay in the residence hall. Everyone staying in the residence hall will be charged. We do not charge by the room.

Conference Participants may accept visitors according to their specific conference's policies.

Visitors, however, may not reside in rooms overnight and will not be issued keys. Conferences will be billed for any non-paying overnight visitors.

Items to Bring: You may want to bring the following items with you for your stay on campus: an alarm clock, bathrobe, slippers, sunblock, books and radio, comfortable clothes, extra cash, toiletries, lightweight jacket, iron, walking shoes, camera and film.

Laundry:

Laundry facilities are located in each of the halls. Washers are one dollar (\$1) and dryers are 25 cents per 18 minute cycle. Those conferees staying for more than one week may exchange their University issued sheets on Thursdays 1:00pm – 9:00pm in the Conference Office. You need to bring your used linens with you for exchange.
