

Our Stack












Customize To Your Needs



Our Process

From the initial meeting with our sponsors, they had very clear requirements on what they expected. As a first step, we created user stories with each having verifiable acceptance criteria. Once these were accepted, we went through various iterations of design mockups as we learned more information about how each feature worked and received feedback on our design. Finally, we proceeded to development which was a learning curve for all of us. At this point, we shifted all of our focus to developing new features each week to get feedback and approval from our sponsors.
