

Are students allowed to modify their course list? I am reading C-6 to mean that having both "discussion math 140a" and "lab math 140a" is not allowed, and I gather that the only way to know the corresponding lecture is by the course number. And really by C-1 "each course has a unique number" you mean each course has a unique number/letter combination and lectures do not have a letter.

Are the room requirements/facilities mentioned in C-9 and R-5 part of a pre-defined list? or maybe room requirements are chosen from a list of all previously entered room facilities? Or is it simply typed in free hand such that if a typo is made or "low ceilings" is specified instead of just omitting "high ceilings" then extraneous penalty points will ensue.

I interpreted UI-2 to mean that a student could save the current information and read the information back in to Schocr from the disk file.. This leads me to believe that the student is allowed to load a previously saved schedule (not course list) into Schocr.. is this true?
