- Exercise 25.1, and 27.1
- Program should be runnable from the command line when in the directory (eg, Users/peter/exercises-in-programming-style-peter/week7/):
 - \$./build_25.py && ./run_25.py
 \$./build_27.py && ./run_27.py
- Make sure the program can be run on the VM, which can be found here.
- Successfully run over Pride and Prejudice available at the root of the directory.
- Note for 25.1: A new version of the VM is available through GitHub that has SQLite3 installed, make sure to test on VM or make PR to repository if other database is used that is not provided in the VM.

- Add the following tag to your final commit "homework-7", see description below.
