Preface, p. xxiii: Robert R. Heckard should be Robert F. Heckard.

- p. 102, Exercise 3.21b: 3.95 should be -3.95, to read "Explain what the slope of -3.95 means..."
- p. 102, Exercise 3.24, displayed equation: The value "1.26" should be "126" (no decimal).
- p. 103, Exercise 3.38, line 1: "exercises" should be "exercise" to read "Refer to the figure for the previous exercise."
- p. 104, Exercise 3.50: In the equation at the end of line 4 the value "1.26" should be "126" (no decimal).
- p. 296, Technical Note box, line just after the displayed equation: ".0224" should be ".0214" to read "which is much closer to the exact binomial probability of .0214..."
- p. 305, Exercise 8.52, in part (c) AND in part (d): "P(X = 6)" should be " $P(X \ge 6)$ "
- p. 360, Exercise 9.62: "standard error of the mean" should be "standard deviation of the sample mean"
- p. 443, exercise 11.38, 4th line: "420" should be "375". Note that "420" *is* the correct page number to list in Line 2, but not in Line 4.
