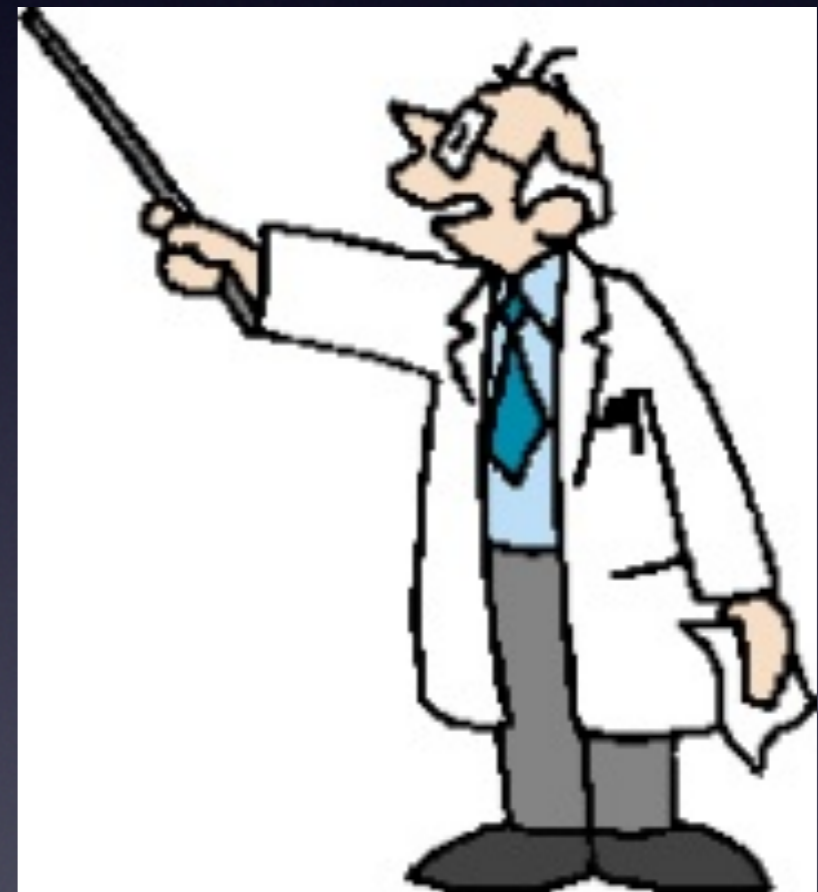
Method: Interview
