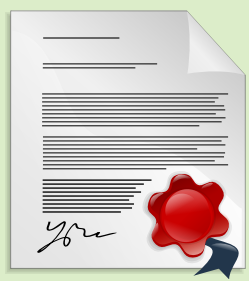

## 4 CREDIT BY EXAMS & SYLLABUS REVIEWS

Both Credit By Exams and Syllabus Reviews are optional unless you fall under one of these scenarios:

- Attended a community college that does not have courses that are accepted at UCI as ICS 31-33, ICS 45C, or 45J AND you have experience in one of the programming languages of Python, C++, or Java
- Attended an out-of-state community college, out-of-state 4 year college/university, another UC, a CSU, or 4 year college/university
