Applying for Graduation

Graduation is not automatic once you complete all your requirements (UC requirements, General Education requirements, Major requirements, Minor requirements if you are pursuing a minor). **You must apply one quarter before your intended graduation date.** The deadline is Friday of Week 8 of the quarter prior to your graduation quarter.

For example: If you plan to graduate in Spring quarter of your senior year, your graduation application must be submitted in Winter quarter.
