WACV 2015: IEEE Winter Conference on Applications of Computer Vision

The IEEE Winter Conference on Applications of Computer Vision solicits proposals for demonstrations to be held in conjunction with WACV 2015. Each demonstration will be accompanied by a two-page description in the conference proceedings.

Important Dates

- Demo proposal deadline: October 10, 2014
- Acceptance notification: October 30, 2014
- Camera-ready copy: Nov 14, 2014

Organization

The ideal demonstration should attract a wide audience, illustrate a new technology, have a live action component, and possibly an interactive component. It should also align with the technical areas covered by the main conference.

Submission Instructions

A demo proposal should include

- Demo descriptions of at most 2 pages, including demo title and presenters, a description of the demo. This should highlight the elements of novelty.
- Auxiliary information:
 - contact information of the presenters
 - equipment brought by the presenters
 - equipment required at the space of the demo
 - space requirements
 - links to videos/web-site illustrating the demo (optional)

Demo proposals should be submitted via email in PDF format to the email address below by the due date. Proposals will be evaluated by the demo chair and conference organizers, with an eye towards selecting engaging demonstrations of novel technology, on a diverse set of topics that will inform and inspire the community.
